

A Bill to Restructure Drug Mandatory Sentencing

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. As of current the United States Policy in regards to handling the victims of drug addiction is inefficient, expensive and does not solve the inherent problem. To correct these issues a new code focusing on rehabilitation and personal betterment must be created. The new code goes as follows. For non-dealing, first time drug offenders; mandatory rehabilitation, 9 months' Probation, and a minimum of 50hrs community service, a misdemeanor shall be added to the persons criminal record. For Second time Offenders; mandatory rehabilitation, 9 months' Probation, and a minimum of 50hrs community service greater than the amount assigned as punishment for the last , a misdemeanor shall be added to the persons criminal record. Should a person be arrested more than three times for Drug charges all charges are changed retroactively as felonies to their record and have a minimum of 5 years prison sentence.

SECTION 2. Non-Dealing: drug possession without the intent to sell

SECTION 3. The Enforcement of this Legislation will be handles by the office of the US Attorney general as well as the Drug Enforcement Agency.

A. At the local level the county attorney will be in charge of the handling of cases

B. Should a prisoners sentence be handed down in violation of this legislation it will be automatic grounds for a mistrial.

SECTION 4. This legislation will come into effect on January 1, 2018

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void
