

A Resolution To Implement a Fair Tax System

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- WHEREAS,** The current tax code is 74,608 pages long, and
- WHEREAS,** Implementing a fair tax would both stimulate the economy and promote expansion and innovation, and
- WHEREAS,** A fair tax is defined by FairTax.org as a national sales tax in which every person living in the United States, rather than paying federal income taxes, payroll taxes, gift taxes, and estate taxes, pays a sales tax of 23% on purchases of new goods and services, excluding necessities due to the prebate (a monthly payment to all family households of lawful U.S. residents of tax on purchases up to the poverty level.), and
- WHEREAS,** Currently, the tax system consists of a 15% income tax bracket and a 7.65% employee payroll tax, with additional sales taxes that vary by state, and
- WHEREAS,** The fair tax system would incentivize growth and development by allowing citizens to receive all of the money that they earn; therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** That the Congress here assembled implement a fair tax system.
