

A Bill to Limit Campaigns for Elected Public Offices to Six Months

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Campaign efforts from candidates for publicly elected offices will be
3 limited to six months before the election

4 **SECTION 2.** “Campaign effort” is defined as any fundraising, campaign organization,
5 or any action to sway public opinion toward a particular candidate;
6 “publicly elected offices” are defined as any government position at any
7 level that requires a regional constituent vote to seat a particular candidate
8 for a given position

9 **SECTION 3.** The Federal Election Commission will oversee the implementation and
10 regulation of this bill, with the backing from appropriate regional courts
11 when conflict arises

12 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect after Election Day 2016

13 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
