## A Bill to Limit Campaigns for Elected Public Offices to Six Months

1	BE IT ENACT	TED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2	<b>SECTION 1</b> .	Campaign efforts from candidates for publicly elected offices will be
3		limited to six months before the election
4	SECTION 2.	"Campaign effort" is defined as any fundraising, campaign organization,
5		or any action to sway public opinion toward a particular candidate;
6		"publicly elected offices" are defined as any government position at any
7		level that requires a regional constituent vote to seat a particular candidate
8		for a given position
9	SECTION 3.	The Federal Election Commission will oversee the implementation and
10		regulation of this bill, with the backing from appropriate regional courts
11		when conflict arises
12	<b>SECTION 4.</b>	This bill will go into effect after Election Day 2016
13	<b>SECTION 5.</b>	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
